Cargo Airport Services USA expands Ground Handling operation at JFK International Airport with Japan Airlines at Building 151

JAMAICA, NEW YORK, June 01, 2009

Cargo Airport Services USA, LLC (“CAS”) has been awarded the cargo warehouse and ramp handling contract with Japan Airlines (JAL) at JFK International Airport. CAS currently serves other customers in building 151 and will also handle JAL customer carrier, Finnair, in the multi tenant warehouse.

JAL, based at Narita International Airport, operates scheduled and non-scheduled international and domestic service to 125 destinations worldwide operating a modern fleet of 279 aircraft. JAL operates Boeing 747 aircraft with ten weekly flights from JFK to Narita, three weekly flights to Sao Paulo and two weekly JAL/NCA freighter code share flights to Narita. Other CAS customers in the 220,000 square foot JAL facility include Cargolux, EVA, Olympic, Pakistan, Aeromexpress, Aerosvit and South African Airways.
